Julian Gilewski - Professor at Virtual University of Piano



Julian Gilewski was born in Warsaw (Poland) in a family of musicians. He began his musical education as a pianist in music school in Warsaw, where he graduated in 2020.

He participated in conducting masterclasses with leading conductors such as: Daniel Oren, Patrick Fournillier and Jerzy Maksymiuk. He had the opportunity to work as an assistant conductor with such figures as Andrey Boreyko, Anna Duczmal-Mróz and Massimiliano Caldi.

He has worked with such orchestras as the Polish Radio Symphony Orchestra in Warsaw, Universitätsorchester Dresden, Chopin University of Music Symphony Orchestra and musical institutions such as Warsaw Chamber Opera.

In the summer of 2023, he will participate in Fiskars Conducting Masterclass, invited conductors including Jukka-Pekka Saraste, Esa-Pekka Salonen and James Gaffigan.

He regularly collaborates with professional choirs and often performs contemporary music with the University Modern Ensemble.

In 2022, he founded an orchestra of young musicians, with which they give regular concerts. In February same year, Julian received a prestigious conducting scholarship from the Jerzy Semkow Foundation.

In March 2023 he won the 1st Prize at the 4th Adam Kopyciński National Conducting Competition in Wrocław, Poland.

In June 2023 he completed his bachelor's degree with honours in the Symphony and Opera Conducting class of Profesor Monika Wolińska at the Fryderyk Chopin University of Music in Warsaw. Currently, he is continuing his master's degree at his alma mater in Warsaw.
